

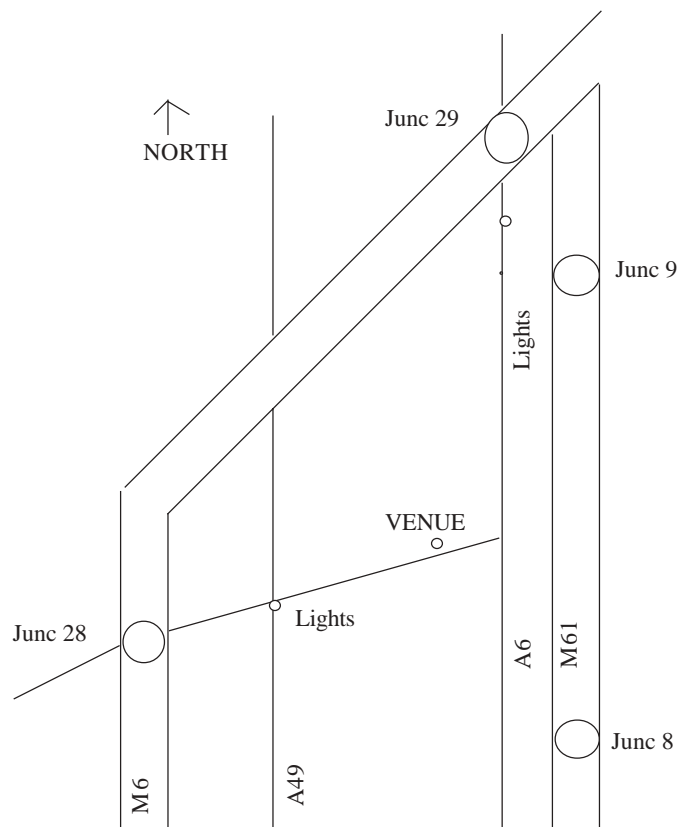
Directions to the Venue

YOUR JUDGES

DOGS – MR ROGER J PUGH (Rocellio)

Roger's involvement in breeding/exhibiting of Staffordshire Bull Terriers has been continuous since the early 70s, however, his interest and association with the breed goes back many years prior to this Along with his wife they have bred and exhibited a number of successful dogs. Nine of which they have exhibited at Crufts. The most notable being Champion Rocellio Miss Supreme who was awarded 9 CCs and 3 RCCs and Champion Rocellio Rip Van Winkle who was awarded 10 CCs and 5 RCCs. They have exported four Rocellio puppies abroad each becoming Champions in their respective countries. Roger's judging experience has included awarding Challenge Certificates on numerous occasions at both Breed and General Championship Shows. He has also made these same awards in Australia (2), South Africa (2), Finland, New Zealand, Netherlands, Germany and the USA. He is very much looking forward to officiating at this event and giving a fair and unbiased opinion of the dogs.

BITCHES – MR KEITH HINCE

After attending the SBTC Training Class with my mentor Mr Bill Till (Rumbow) I decided to try my hand at breeding. I owned two dogs but never a bitch. In 1978 I purchased a puppy bitch, Astaff Broadway Queen (Ch Montbell Barbarosa x Ch Kinderijk Petite Cherie) who was a sound whelp. Two dog pups from the early litters were shown, Sagacious Samurai, who had numerous wins at Open Shows and 2 wins at the NWSBTC Ch Show under Mr J Bolton, sadly a family break up ended his show career, and Broadway Black Marauder who also had many Open Show wins. We then bred Desperado Cossack who was prolific at stud, and in just a few matings produced Ch Black Ice, Shining Black Sabre, Winston the Lionheart, Inca Queen of Astaff, Invisible Halo, Our Amber Princess, all having good wins at Ch Show level. Ch Black Ice and Shining Black Sabre also winning at Crufts. After purchasing a lovely bitch, Kilnmartyra Girl, she was mated twice to Ch Spirestaff Jimmy Jazz, Ch Tearaway Temptress, Present Arms and Hopeful Shot. Both the latter dogs being shown successfully at all levels. Last but no means least came Classic Find at Alport who has produced two Champions and several Crufts qualifiers. I have served on two Committees, West Midlands Terrier Society and The SBT Club where I ran the training class for a number of years and also served as Club Chairman. I have been judging since 1989 including two Championship Shows, City of Birmingham (Dogs) and Irish Fanciers Ch Show (Both sexes) and very much look forward to judging at the NWSBTC Championship Show.

DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

1. In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by The Kennel Club.
2. Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows.
3. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society.
4. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. 20th February 2009
5. Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering in Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A first prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value.
6. If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-
 - (1) Withdrawal - The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations 9(j) and 20.
 - (2) Transfer - a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of their being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height. b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy Class, Puppy Class or Junior Class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy Class, Junior Class or Yearling Class respectively for the correct colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of their being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling Class to the Open Class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height. c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer It to the Open Class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height. d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

MINOR PUPPY:	For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on first the day of the Show.
PUPPY:	For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.
JUNIOR:	For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.
MAIDEN:	For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or a First Prize at an Open or Championship show (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).
NOVICE:	For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more First Prizes at Open and Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).
GRADUATE:	For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not.
POST GRADUATE:	For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not.
LIMIT:	For dogs which have not become show Champions under the Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club or won 7 or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes confined to the Breed, whether restricted or not at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.
OPEN:	For all dogs of the breed for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.
VETERAN:	For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

DEFINITIONS CONTD.

OPEN: For all dogs of the Breed for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at this Show.

VETERAN: For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day the day of the Show.

A W A CAIRNS SPECIAL For all dogs who are handled and owned by their breeders

MEMORIAL BREEDERS:

ALBERT RAWNSLEY & A D THOMAS SPECIAL For all dogs of the breed for which the class is provided. The entry monies will be divided proportionately as Prize Money.

MEMORIAL STAKES:

NOT FOR COMPETITION: Dogs may be entered "Not For Competition" at the entry fee of £2.00

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. **OPENING OF SHOW:** The Show will open at 8.30 am
2. **ARRIVAL OF DOGS:** Dogs will be received at any time but it is the exhibitors responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
3. **JUDGING TIME:** Judging will commence at 9.30am in both rings.
4. **REMOVAL OF DOGS:** Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
5. **COOKING STOVES:** The use of cooking stoves is forbidden except as authorised by the Show Management.
6. **FEES:** £12.00 per Dog subsequent fee with same dog £1.00 per class (Excluding Stakes) Veteran Classes Free, Not For Competition £2.00 per dog, £2.00 - A.D. Thomas Special Memorial Stakes Class & Albert Rawnsley Special Memorial Stakes Class
7. **PRIZE MONEY:** Will not be paid at this Show.
8. **REFUSAL OF ENTRIES:** The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries or advertisements.
9. **PUPPIES:** Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition/or entry.
10. **MATING OF BITCHES:** The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
11. **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW:** Where a Best Puppy in Show is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed & is unbeaten by any other puppy exhibited at the same Show. A puppy is a dog of six & not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best of Breed or Best in Show is a puppy it will automatically be Best Puppy in Breed & Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently selection of Best Puppy in Breed & Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed & Best in Show respectively.
WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITION: Puppies which become eligible for Best Puppy in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition other than breed classes & Best Puppy in Breed prior to the competition for Best Puppy in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A Puppy beaten in competition for Best Puppy in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dog declared Best Puppy in Show, however, must not compete in any subsequent competition.
PROVISO: For the Purpose of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace & Team or a Special Award confined to a single breed will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
12. **BEST IN SHOW:** The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed & is unbeaten by any other dog exhibited at the same Show. Best in Show must be selected from the exhibits declared Best of Sex providing they are unbeaten winning dogs. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the Best Opposite Sex and the Reserve Best of Sex to the exhibit declared Best in Show.
WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITION: Dogs which become eligible for Best in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition other than Breed classes and Best of Breed prior to the competition for Best in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A dog beaten in competition for Best in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dogs declared Best in Show & Reserve Best in Show, however, must not compete in any subsequent competition.
PROVISO: For the Purpose of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace & Team or a Special Award confined to one breed will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
13. Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of 10 minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
14. **REGULATIONS:** No modifications will be made to this schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the canine press when ever possible.
15. **PREPARATION FOR EXHIBITION:** All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F Annex B - Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
16. **OVERSEAS EXHIBITS:** All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
17. Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts traveling to and whilst at KC licensed events.

17. Contd.
- 1) When traveling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
 - 2) If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether traveling to the show is a good idea at all.
 - 3) The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
 - 4) Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
 - 5) When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
 - 6) Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
 - 7) Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time. Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.
- WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.
- Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
18. NOT FOR COMPETITION: Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered
 19. DOG FOULING: Any owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is requested to
 20. UNENTERED DOGS - No animal other than an exhibit shall be brought into the precincts of A Dog Show during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee.
 21. The Show Management reserve the right to refuse admission to the Show.
 22. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES: If required a self addressed, stamped postcard should be sent with entries.
 23. CHILDREN: Children must be kept under control at all times.
 24. DOGS IN CARS: Owners leaving dogs unattended in cars on hot days may be reported to the Kennel Club (KC Rule 42)
 25. BANK CHARGES: Any Bank charges incurred by dishonoured cheques will be passed onto the exhibitor involved.
 26. SAFETY: Exhibitors may be asked by the Show Manager to stack their cages in the interest of safety.
 27. NO SMOKING: No smoking in the Hall - as Smoke Alarms are fitted.
 28. REGULATIONS F. F9 EXHIBITION OF DOGS:
 - a) No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time whilst at the licensed venue including its environs, car park and caravan parks and approaches.
 - b) The owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at Kennel Club events must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car & caravan parks & approaches.

**REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOG
FOR EXHIBITIONS F (B)**

1. These regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these show regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A42.(a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained there. (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these regulations, he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under rule A42.
2. (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the show.
(b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:-
 - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee.
 - (b) The removal of dew claws of any breed.
 - (c) Operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
4. The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from The Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by The Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.
