I started showing over 30 years ago Dobermann progressing in the late 80s to judging at Open Shows, then awarded CCs first in 1996 to date, 9 occasions for Dobermann. My next Dobermann appointment is Bitches at Crufts 2013. I have campaigned 1 Dobermann to the title of Champion. 4, Belgian Shepherds and 1 Schipperke between them it total 44 CCs.

At the time of writing I award CCs to 3 breeds in the Working Group and 2 in the Pastoral Group with the numbers set to increase soon subject to Kennel Club approval.

You would often find me around SBT ring in the Mid 90s as friends of mine from Runcorn made up Ch Nordic Chief, a pied male.

My own journey with SBT began in 2005 when I purchased a bitch from Gwen and Alan Small 'Bethane' she is sired by Ch Harkline Robbie the Bruce, I bred her in 2008 to Ch Stormbull So Wot, I kept a bitch for myself so I now have 2, but I let Eric & Catrina McPhail from Scotland take a nice bitch, Nightstorm's Next Top Model, my proudest moment was seeing her win the Reserve CC at Blackpool 2011.

I am on the B judging list for SBT with over 100 dogs judged hands on, and can honestly say that I am looking forward to judge this Limit show in January 2012, and I am taking this opportunity to thank the committee for this prestigious appointment.

# DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

1. Wins at Championship Shows in Breed Classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows.
2. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members classes or competing for Members Specials, each Member of such partnership must at the time of entry be a Member of this Club.
3. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to & including the seventh day before the date of closing of entries shall be counted when entering for any class. ie. **30th December 2011**.
4. Wins in variety class do not count for entry in breed classes, but when entering variety classes wins in both breed & variety classes must be counted. A first prize does not include a Special prize of whatever value.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

1. Withdrawal - the dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations 9(j) & 20.

2. Transfer - a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy & Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.

b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy class or Junior class, which is over age but under 12 calendar months or 18 calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy class, Junior class or Yearling class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling class to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.

c) For any reason other than above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.

If an exhibit arrives late & misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may NOT be transferred to any other class.

**MINOR PUPPY:** For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**PUPPY:** For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**JUNIOR:** For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**YEARLING:** For dogs of *twelve* and not exceeding twenty four calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**NOVICE:** For dogs which have not won three first prizes at any Show (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy & Special Puppy classes excepted whether restricted or not)

**GRADUATE:** For dogs which have not won four or more first prizes at Open or Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit & Open classes, whether restricted or not.

**POST GRADUATE:** For dogs which have not won five or more First prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit & Open classes whether restricted or not.

**LIMIT:** For dogs which have not won seven or more First Prizes in all, at Open and Championship Shows in Limit & Open classes, confined to the Breed, whether restricted or not

**OPEN:** For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided & eligible for entry at the Show.

**VETERAN:** For dogs of seven years and over on the first day of the Show.

**NOT FOR COMPETITION:** Dogs may be entered as "Not for Competition" at the entry fee of £2.00  
**All dogs accepted NFC must be 4 calendar months or over and KC registered. Full KC details must be given on the entry form.**

## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. OPENING OF SHOW: The Show will open at 10.30am
2. ARRIVAL OF DOGS: Dogs will be received at any time but it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
3. JUDGING TIME: Judging will commence at 11.00am. Dogs first in the ring.
4. REMOVAL OF DOGS: Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
5. COOKING STOVES: The use of cooking stoves is forbidden except as authorised by the Show Management.
6. FEES: £3.50 any number of classes per dog, NFC & veteran @£2.00.
7. PRIZE MONEY: Will NOT be paid at this Show.
8. REFUSAL OF ENTRIES: The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
9. PUPPIES: Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
10. MATING OF BITCHES: The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
11. BEST PUPPY IN SHOW (if Scheduled): Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and is unbeaten by any other puppy exhibited at the same show. A Puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the show. Where the Best in Show is a puppy it will also automatically be Best Puppy in Show. Similarly, if the Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it will also automatically be Best Puppy in Show. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best in Show. Best Puppy in Show must be selected from puppies which have been judged and which are unbeaten by any other puppy. Puppies which become eligible for Best Puppy in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition, other than Breed classes prior to the competition for Best Puppy in Show as appropriate, in order to remain unbeaten. A puppy beaten in competition for Best Puppy in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dog declared Best Puppy in Show, however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. PROVISO For the purpose of the Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Sward confined to one breed will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
12. BEST IN SHOW: The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed & is unbeaten by any other dog exhibited at the same Show. Best in Show must be selected from the exhibits declared Best of Sex providing they are unbeaten winning dogs. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the Best Opposite Sex and the Reserve Best of Sex to the exhibit declared Best in Show. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show must not compete in any subsequent competition. Dogs which become eligible for Best in Show maybe withdrawn from all other competition, other than breed classes prior to the competition for Best in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A dog beaten in competition for Best in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. PROVISO: For the Purpose of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace & Team or a Special Award confined to one breed, will not be considered to be beaten dogs.
13. Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of 10 minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
14. REGULATIONS: No modifications will be made to this schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the canine press wherever possible.
15. PREPARATION FOR EXHIBITION: All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F Annex B - Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
16. OVERSEAS EXHIBITS: All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.

## RULES & REGS CONTD.

17. Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
  - 1) When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
  - 2) If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
  - 3) The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
  - 4) Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
  - 5) When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
  - 6) Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so you dog stays well hydrated.
  - 7) Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time. Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.  
**WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.**  
Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
18. NOT FOR COMPETITION: Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered
19. DOG FOULING: Any owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog/s at any Kennel Club Licensed Show within the licensed venue & within the environs of the event including car & caravan parks & approaches (Facilities are available so to do)
20. UNENTERED DOGS - No animal other than an exhibit shall be brought into the precincts of A Dog Show during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee.
21. The Show Management reserve the right to refuse admission to the Show.
22. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES: If required a self addressed, stamped postcard should be sent with entries.
23. CHILDREN: Children must be kept under control at all times.
24. DOGS IN CARS: Owners leaving dogs unattended in cars on hot days may be reported to the Kennel Club (KC Rule 42)
25. BANK CHARGES: Any Bank charges incurred by dishonoured cheques will be passed onto the exhibitor involved
26. SAFETY: Exhibitors may be asked by the Show Manager to stack their cages in the interest of safety.
27. REGULATIONS F. F9 EXHIBITION OF DOGS:
  - a) No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time whilst at the licensed venue including its environs, car park and caravan parks and approaches.
  - b) The owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at Kennel Club events must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car & caravan parks & approaches..

Under no circumstances will unentered dogs be allowed in the Show (KC Rule F1 [11]).  
Staffordshire Bull Terriers over **FOUR** calendar months of age may be entered "Not For Competition" by completion of entry form and payment of the relevant fee prior to or on the day (NFC only) at the discretion of the committee

### FOULING BY DOGS



As required by the Kennel Club, may we remind exhibitors that they are responsible for clearing up any fouling made by dogs in their charge, whether it be inside the hall or outside. Anyone failing to clear up will be reported to the Committee who may enforce their right to refuse entries from that exhibitor for future Shows.

Owners leaving dogs unattended in cars on hot days will be reported to the Kennel Club (KC Rule 42)

Exhibits may be removed from the Show after they have been judged.

The Kennel Club requests that all dogs in soft cages are **NOT** left unattended at any time, for safety reasons.

**NO SMOKING IN THE HALL**

**REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS  
FOR EXHIBITION F (B)**

1. These regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these show regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A42. (a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained there. (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these regulations, he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under rule A42.
2. (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the show. (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:  
(a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee. (b) The removal of dewclaws of any breed (c) Operations to prevent breeding provided such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown. Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
4. The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination & analysis.
5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by any official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show & the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

The Officers & Committee of the North West Staffordshire Bull Terrier Club do not accept responsibility for any products advertised or sold by Stall Holders and/or Trade Stands at this Show. Exhibitors are reminded that products on sale by Trade Stands for the preparation & grooming of dogs may not meet the requirements for the Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
